



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

2011 PENSACOLA DOUBLE BRIDGE RUN

Where can I pick up my race packet?

Packet pickup begins Thursday, February 3rd at the Hilton Gulf Front Pensacola Beach (12 Via DeLuna Drive) at 4:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. It continues on Friday, February 4th at the Hilton from 12:00 noon to 8:00 p.m.

Can someone else pick up my race packet for me?

Yes.

Is there any packet pickup the morning of the race?

No, there is no scheduled packet pickup the morning of the race

Can I register the morning of the race?

No.

When does online registration end?

You can register online at active.com through Tuesday, February 1st.

What if I miss the online cut-off?

You can still register Thursday and Friday at the Race Expo at the Hilton Gulf Front Pensacola. Times are 4:00 to 9:00 p.m. on Thursday and 12:00 noon to 8:00 p.m. on Friday.

Will the races fill up?

The 15K is capped at 2500 runners, please register early!

The 5K is capped at 1200 runners and 300 walkers, so it is possible all the races could be full and registration will be closed at that time.

Where should I park?

Park at Pensacola Beach (where you will be assisted by parking volunteers), take the shuttle to the start area of your respective race. **15K shuttles will run from 5:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m. ONLY**, and the **5K shuttles will run from 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 a.m.**

Can I park at the Start area?

Yes, there is parking available at both the 15K and 5K start areas, but there will be no shuttle transportation back to the start areas after the race.

How will the Corral start for the 15K be set up?

For the 15K only, there will be corrals labeled with minute-per-mile pace; runners will be asked to line themselves up by their own pace. The fastest runners will go off first, followed 30-60 seconds later by the next corral, on down the line.

It will be important to listen to the instructions given at the 15K start and to follow directions of event staff. It is anticipated that there will be 8 to 10 corrals (identifiable by signage) with 200 –250 runners in each.

If I register late will I still get a shirt?

We can only guarantee shirts to the first 2,000 registrants, so register as soon as you can.

Is there a minimum race pace?

For the 15K you must maintain a **14-minute mile pace** (this is a change from previous years).

The course will close at **9:30 A.M.**

What about the Friday night dinner?

It is complimentary for runners and \$5 for guests, but you must make a reservation by Monday, January 31st and pick up your ticket(s) at Packet Pickup at the Hilton Gulf Front. It will be a boxed pasta dinner at Hemingway's (on Portofino Boardwalk) from 5:00 to 9:00 p.m. on Friday night.

If I am registered and can't make the race will I still get a shirt?

If you cannot make the race on Saturday morning and you were one of the first 2000 to register, you will be able to pick your shirt up at the PSA office (101 W. Main Street, Pensacola, FL 32502) after Tuesday, Feb. 8th. Office hours are from 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Monday - Thursday and 8:00 a.m.- 12:00 noon on Fridays.

Can I buy an extra shirt?

There will be Double Bridge Run merchandise for sale at the Race Expo at the Hilton Gulf Front Pensacola Beach beginning Thursday, Feb. 3rd, continuing Friday Feb. 4th and at the post-race party on Saturday (Bimini Bar/Hemingway's); whether there will be any shirts for sale depends on the number of late registrants.
